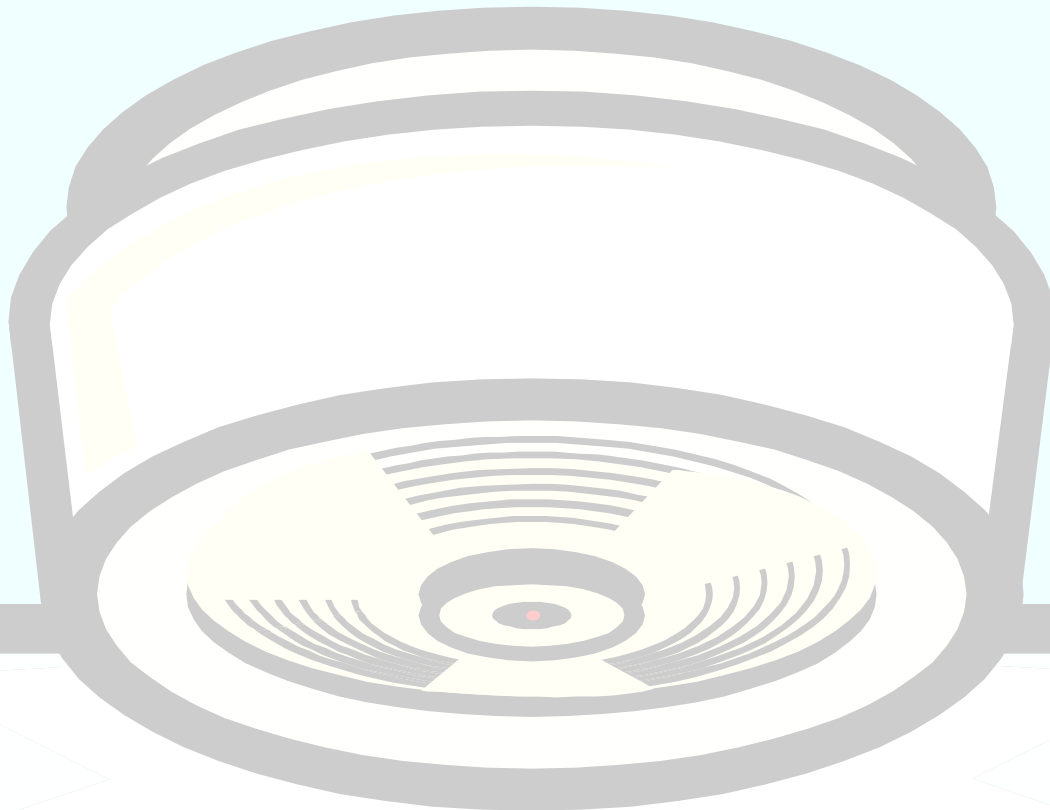


SMOKE DETECTOR INSTALLATION AND TESTING PROCEDURES



A working **SMOKE DETECTOR** is your first line of defense in the home in the event of fire to make sure you GET OUT unharmed. There should be one on each level of the home, in the hallway leading to bedrooms and inside each bedroom and in other living areas.

- Test monthly by pushing the button for a few seconds
- Replace batteries twice a year when the clock time changes
- Replace batteries if you hear a “chirping” sound
- Replace units after 10 years or using manufacturer’s directions

If your Detector does not work properly, it may not alert you in the event of a fire in your home. Great a plan for your escape !
